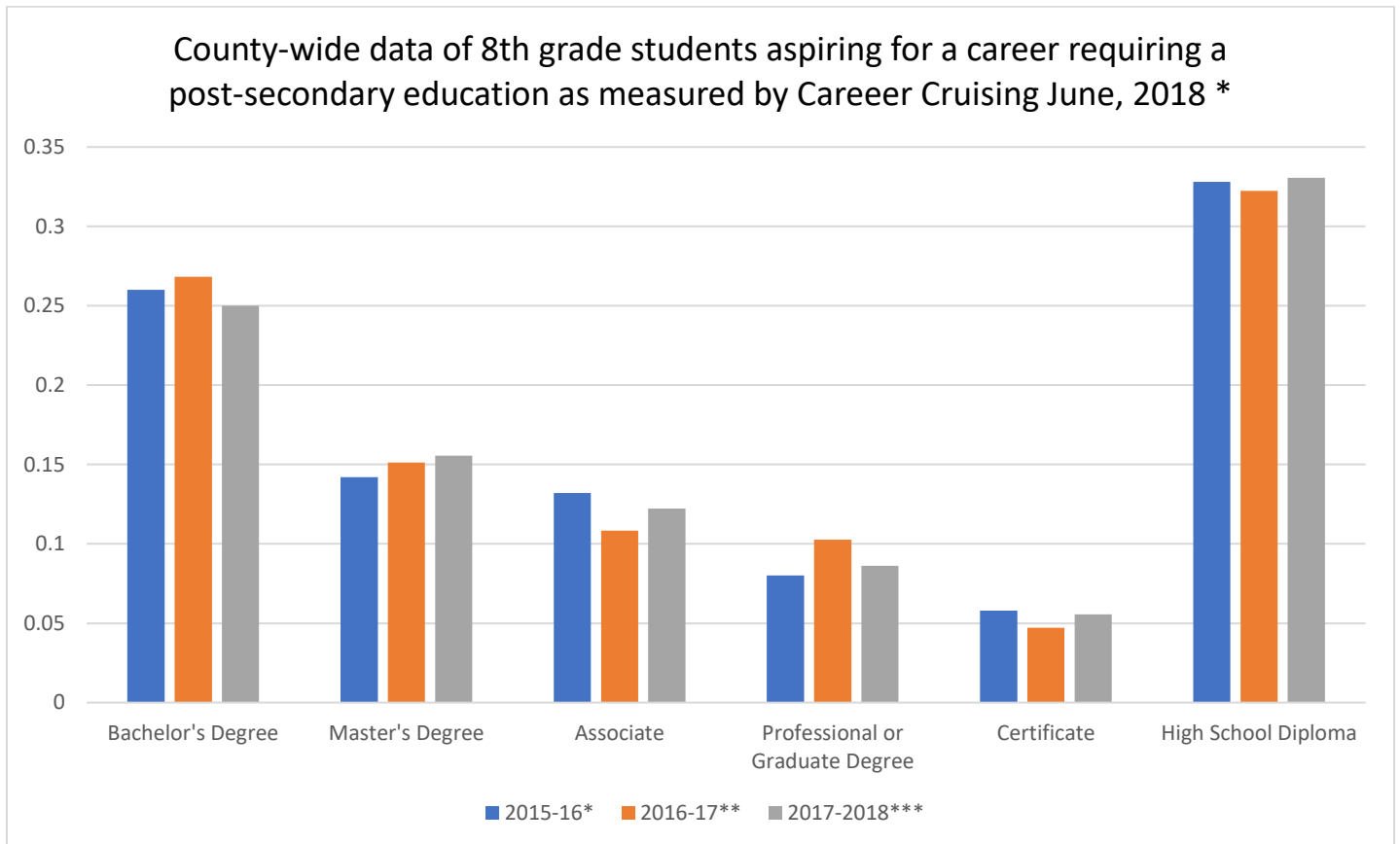


Barry Career Access Network Dashboard as of September 28, 2018

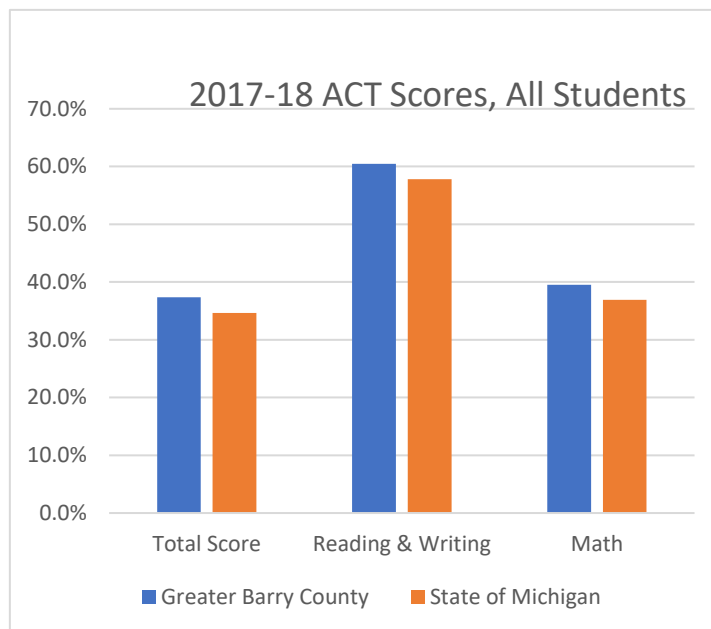
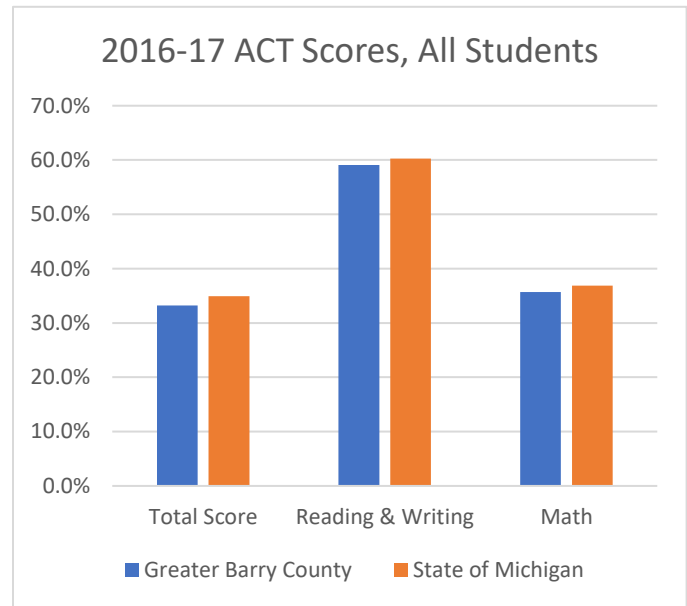

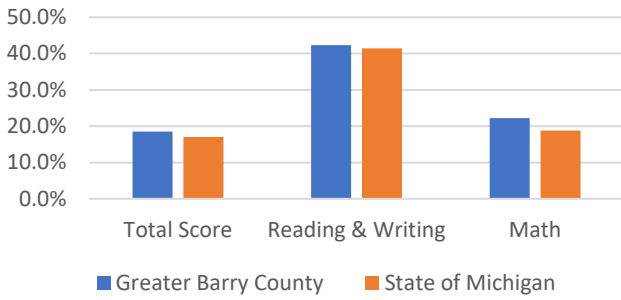

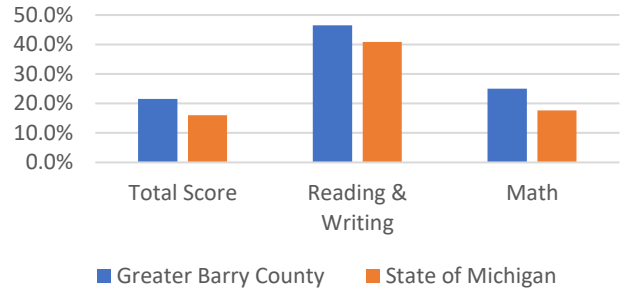

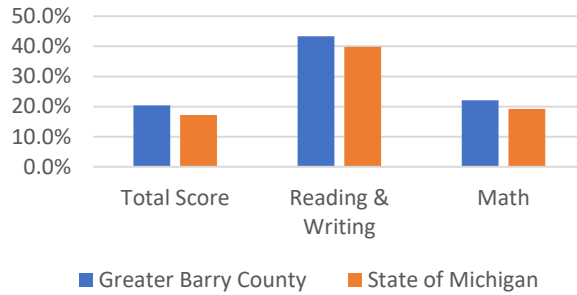
2015-16 ACT Scores, Economically Disadvantaged Students



2016-17 ACT Scores, Economically Disadvantaged Students



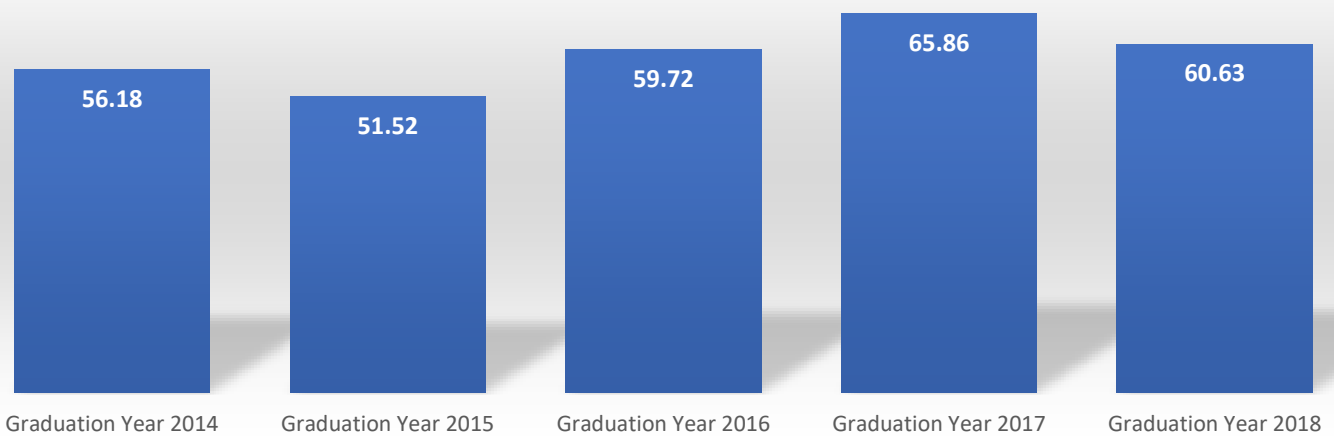
2017-18 ACT Scores, Economically Disadvantaged Students

GREATER BARRY COUNTY FAFSA COMPLETION RATE



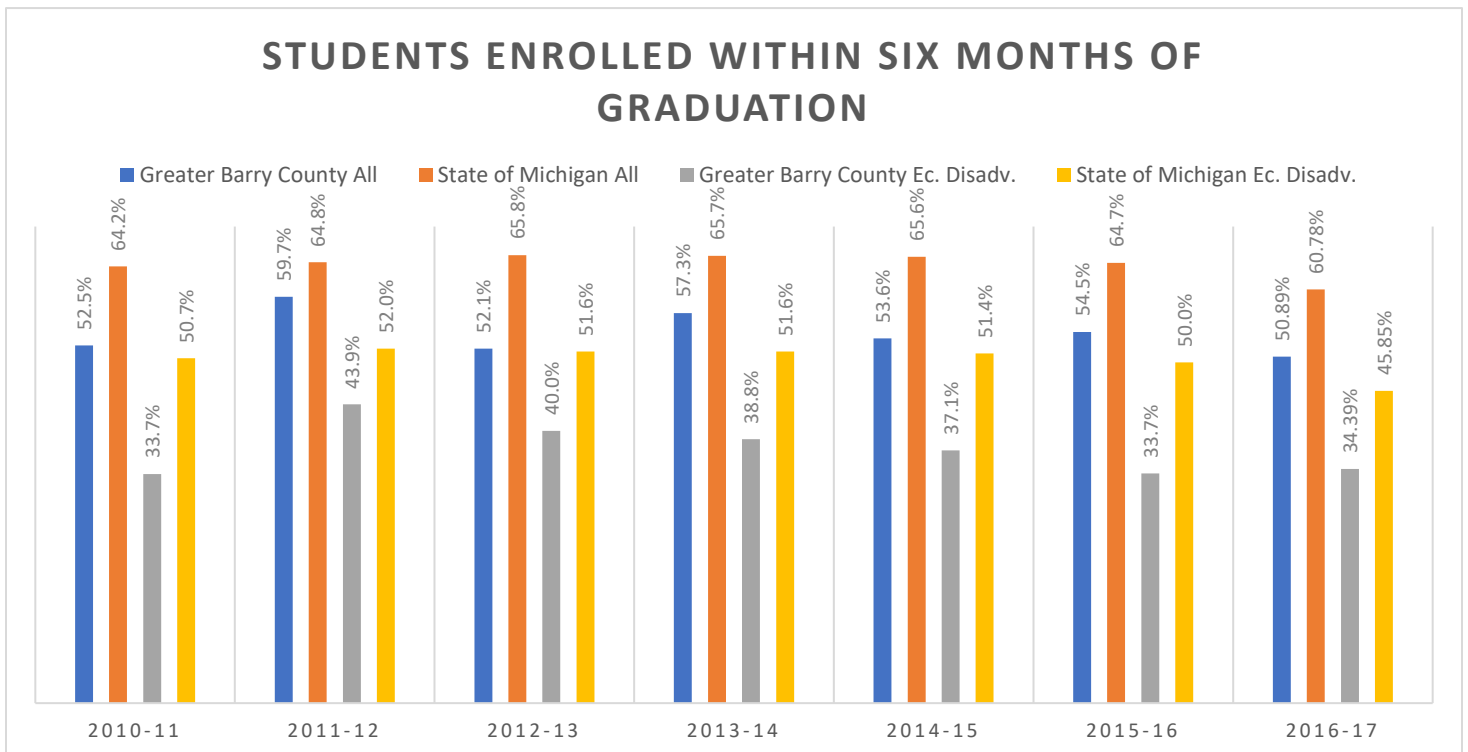
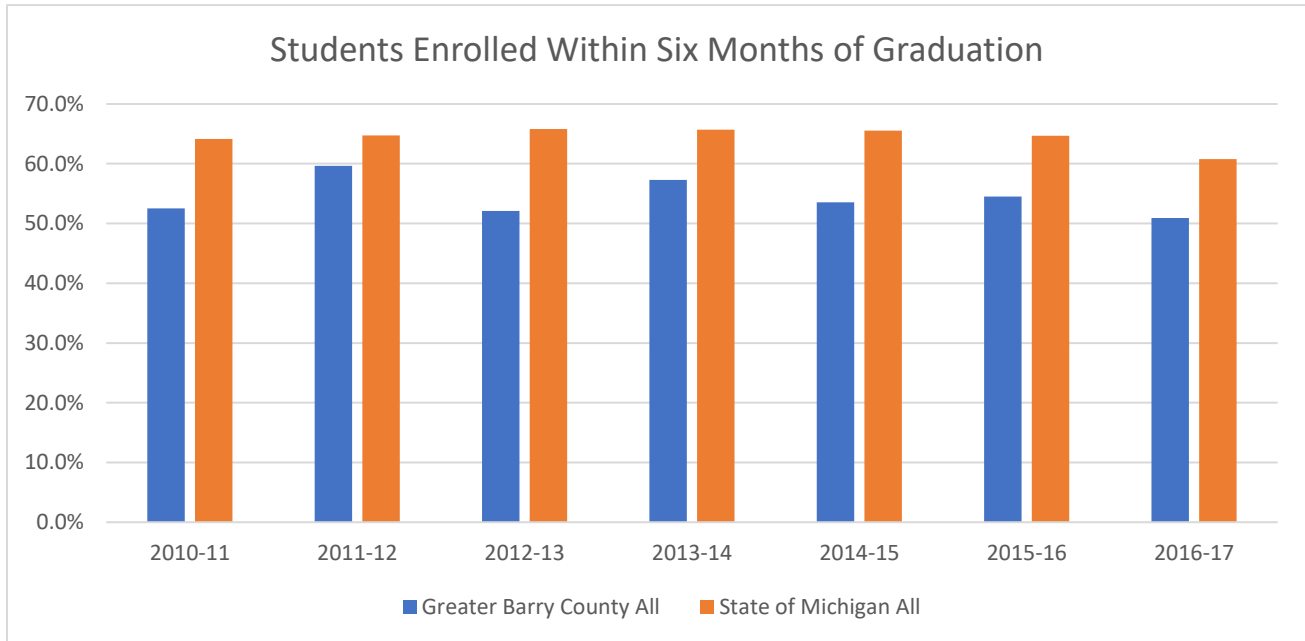

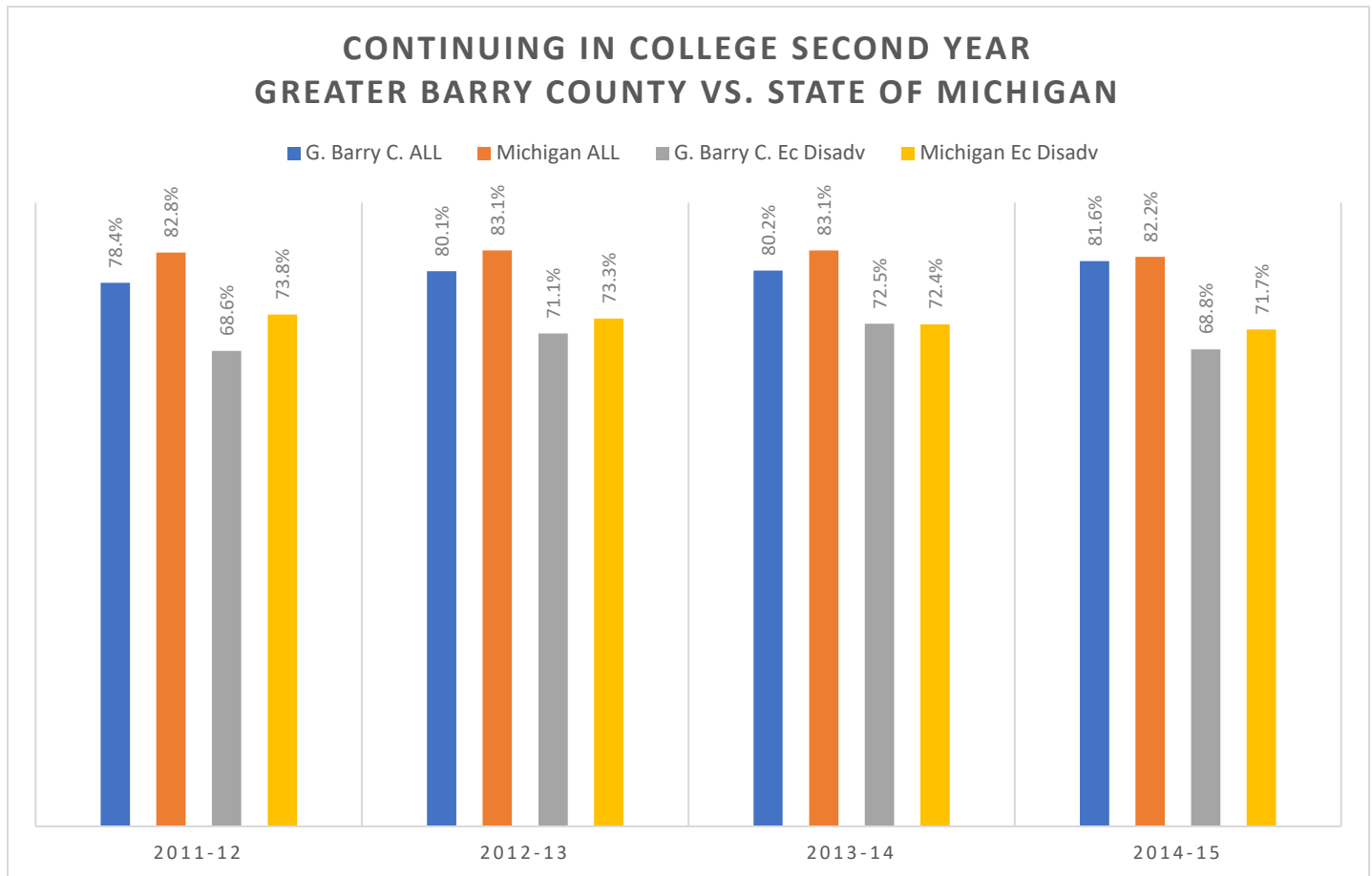

Obtain post-high school certificate or degree within six years of high school graduation.

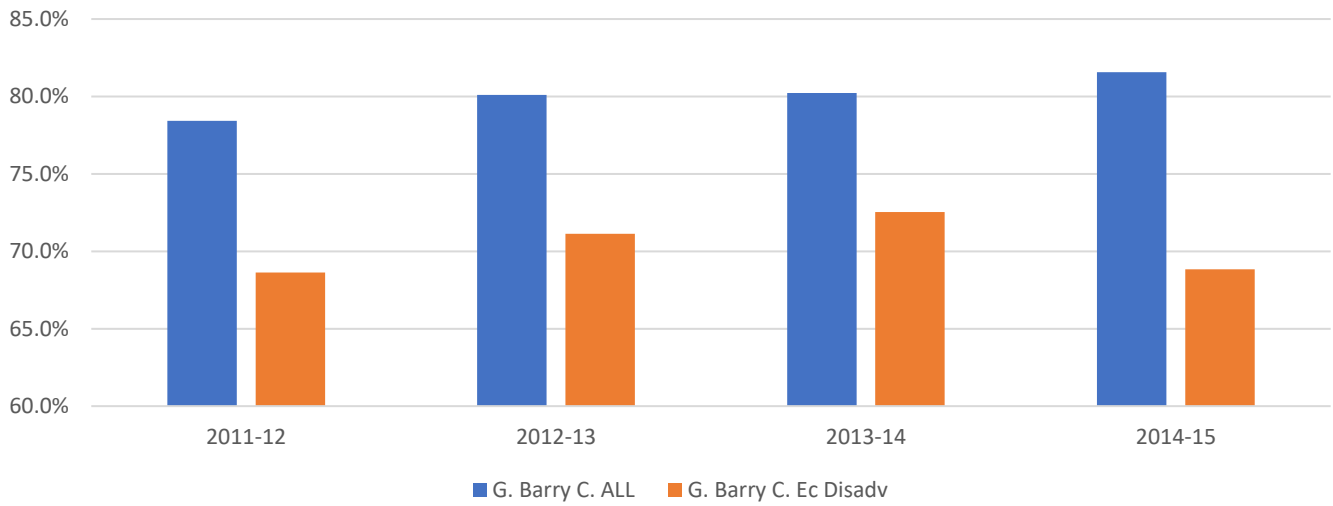

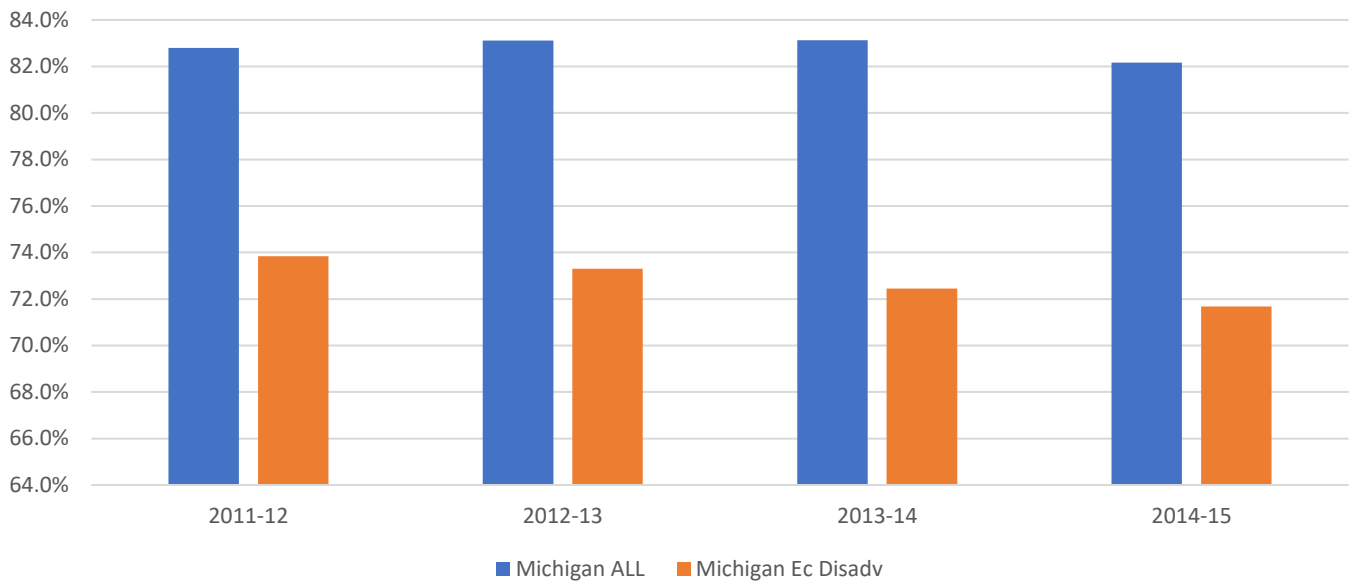

All Students vs Economically Disadvantaged**



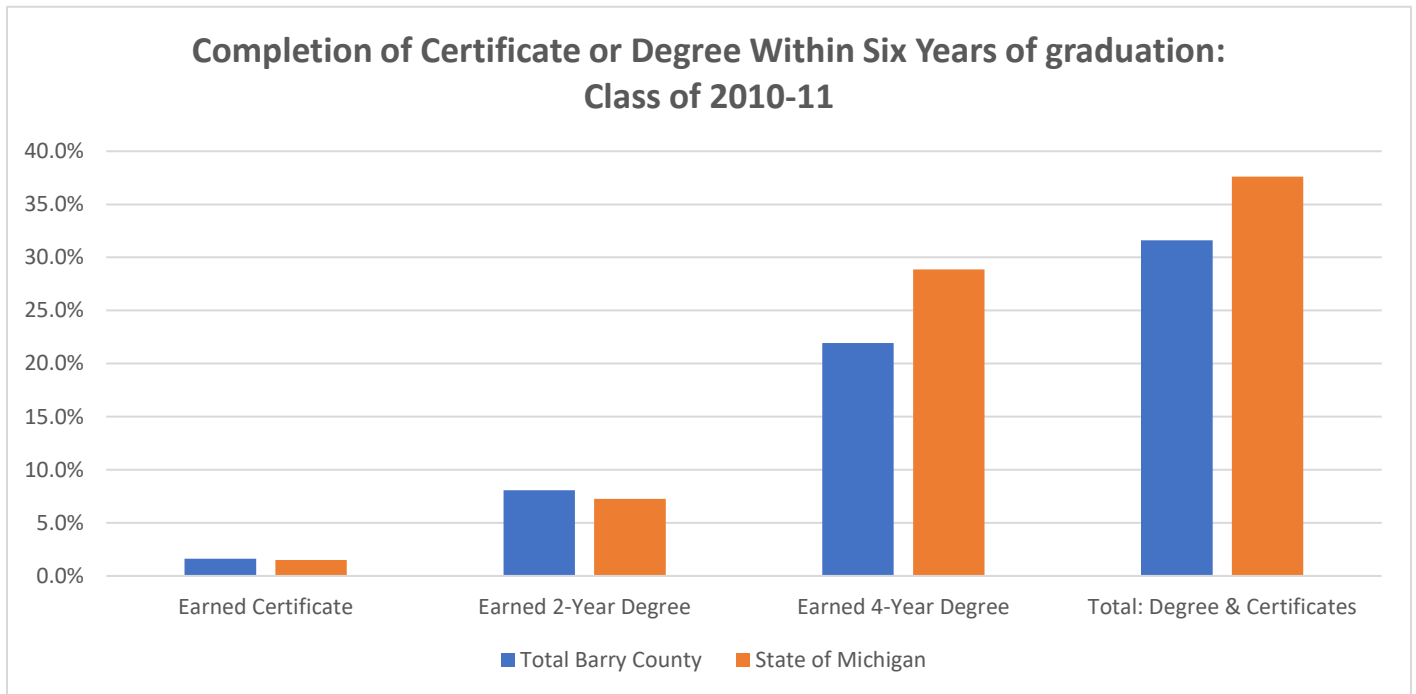
